VENDOR FEE:

Early bird special: save \$30 if paid by June, 1.

Regular cost: \$540.00 for food vendors and \$340 for everyone else. All the payments must be made by August, 10. An additional \$50.00 must be added if electricity is required. Payments accepted in a form of check only. Application fees are due at the time of application. Space number and location assigned by NW Ukrainian International Festival. Vendor must have own Pop-up Tent (tents are provided for food vendors), tables, and other equipment required by fire, building, police or any other City of Bellevue department and organizer. Vendors must agree to be set up a day prior the scheduled open times of the event. Vendors must remain open until scheduled Event finish times – NO EARLY TAKE DOWNS.

SPECIAL NOTES FOR CONCESSIONAIRES: All food vendors are required by the state of Washington to hold a valid food permit from a health department. A temporary food permit can be obtained from King County Health Department, 206-296-4940. Food permits must be submitted to NW Ukrainian International Festival's representative no later than **August 15, 2017** for final vendor approval. No vendors will be accepted for participation in the event after August 20, 2017.
